do not attend school

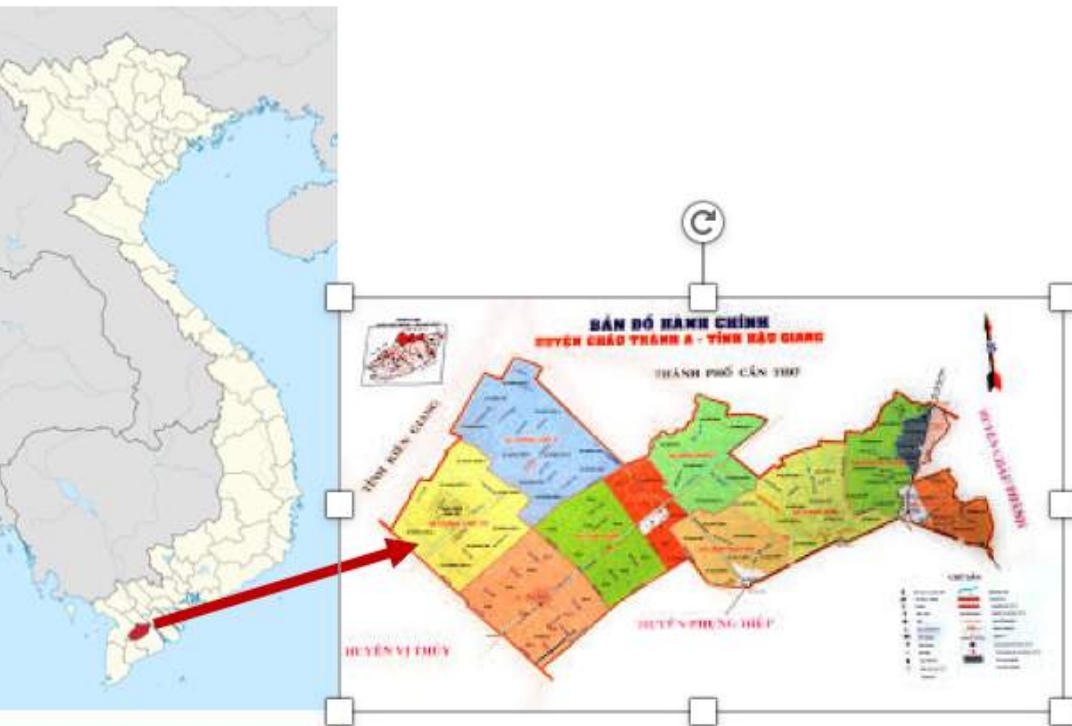
Girls count for 53% of out-of-

GOAL

OBJECTIVES

The goal is to break the cycle of poverty through education of girls in Chau Thanh A district of Hau Giang province in Vietnam

Objective 1: In 36 months, Bong Sen and key stakeholders have identified the majority of girls in the Chau Thanh A district who are interested in school and are at risk of dropout due their family situation.

Objective 2: In 36 months, 84 scholarships provide to 28 underprivileged girls identified above and make a contract with the family ensuring to keep the girls at school.



EXPECTED OUTCOMES

01

Increased the higher engagement of local stakeholders that ensure the program its sustainable.

70% of program stakeholders statistically acknowledge the benefit of the program

02

Increased the ability of the unfortunate girls to stay longer in school

- 84 scholarships for 28 low income girls
- Increase attending rates for girls
- Reduce 40% of schooling cost per school year for low-income students
- 80% of scholarship recipients statistically acknowledge the benefit of the project

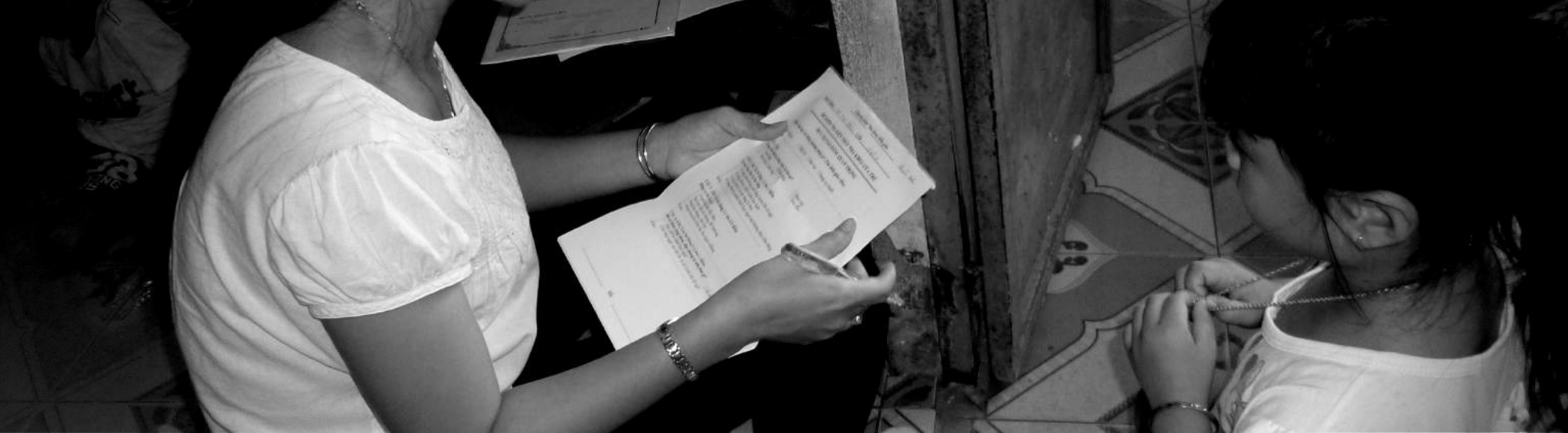
